USA Gymnastics – Kentucky Rules & Policies 2016 – 2017

New Material is highlighted in **yellow**

Kentucky Qualifier Meets

1. Kentucky Qualifier (KQ) system:

- a. A Kentucky Qualifier (KQ) meet is a USA Gymnastics sanctioned competition that has been designated by the USA Gymnastics – KY State Committee as a meet at which a gymnast may earn a qualifying score in order to advance to the Kentucky State Championships.
- b. Levels 2 – 5 & Xcel gymnasts **MUST** compete in at least 2 KQ meets and achieve the qualifying score in at least one KQ meet to qualify to State meet.

2. KQ meet requirements:

- a. KQ meets must submit a bid form to the State Administrative Committee.
- b. No more than 2 KQ meets will be awarded per weekend.
 - i. Preference will be given in order of received and approved bids
 - ii. Bid acceptance dates are 06/01/2017 – 06/30/2017. No bids will be accepted early.
- c. KQ meets must be open invitations to all USA Gymnastics – Kentucky member clubs. The meet may also be open to out of state USA Gymnastics competitors.
- d. KQ meets must follow the sanctioning procedures as listed in the USA Gymnastics R&P.
 - i. Refer to chapter 9 part 1 in USA Gymnastics R&P for pre-meet flyer requirements.
 - ii. Equipment description: Meet Directors must list manufacturer(s) & type for all available equipment, including spring boards.
- e. KQ meets must follow the age group and awards requirements as described in the USA Gymnastics – Kentucky R&P.
- f. KQ meets must be hosted by a Kentucky member club or Kentucky organization (KY NAWGJ).
- g. It is suggested that non removable wristbands be used as sign-in credentials at KQ meet.

3. KQ maximum competition fees:

- a. Levels 2 – 5 \$55.00 (in gym)
- b. Levels 6 – 10 \$65.00 (in gym)
- c. Xcel Bronze, Silver, & Gold \$55.00 (in gym)
- d. Xcel Platinum & Diamond \$65.00 (in gym)
- e. KQ meets using rented facilities and rented equipment are exempt from the above fee requirements. However, it is strongly encouraged to follow the fee requirements for level 2s.
- f. Entry fees are not refundable with less than 10 days prior notice to the meet director.

4. KQ minimum age required to compete as per level:

- a. Level 2 must have reached their 5th birthday.
- b. Level 3 must have reached their 6th birthday.
- c. Levels 4 – 7 must have reached their 7th birthday.
- d. Levels 8 & 9 must have reached their 8th birthday.
- e. Level 10 must have reached their 9th birthday.
- f. Xcel Bronze must have reached their 5th birthday.
- g. Xcel Silver must have reached their 6th birthday.
- h. Xcel Gold must have reached their 7th birthday.
- i. Xcel Platinum must have reached their 8th birthday.
- j. Xcel Diamond must have reached their 9th birthday.

5. KQ age determinations: Age as of the last day of the championship meet.

- a. Levels 2 & 3 **03/26/2017** (State)
- b. Levels 4, 5, & 6 **03/12/2017** (State)
- c. Level 7 & 8 **04/23/2017** (Regional)
- d. Level 9 **04/30/2017** (Eastern)
- e. Level 10 **05/07/2017** (J.O. National)
- f. Xcel Bronze **03/26/2017** (State)
- g. Silver – Diamond **05/14/2017** (Regional)

6. KQ age groups and sizes:

- a. Consecutive ages can be combined.
- b. No single age group can exceed 15 athletes.
- c. Sessions may be divided by teams or by age groups.
- d. Must follow guidelines in USA Gymnastics R&P.

7. KQ award requirements: Levels 2 – 10 & Xcel.

- a. Achievement ribbons are no longer required for events following the USA Gymnastics R&P.
- b. Individual events: placement medals, plaques, or trophies must be given to the top 1/3 of each age group. Additional awards may be given.
- c. All-around placements: gold, silver, and bronze by percentage must be given to each gymnast. Also special recognition is given to the top 3 in each age group with medals, plaques, or trophies.
- d. Pre-meet information must describe the awards to be given at the meet.

8. KQ team awards:

- a. A team consists of a minimum of 3 gymnasts.
- b. The top 3 scores per event will be used to calculate ALL team awards.
- c. Every team that pays a team entry fee must receive a TEAM AWARD.

9. KQ judging requirements:

- a. All levels 2 – 10 & Xcel divisions must have two judge panels for each event.
- b. Xcel divisions Bronze, Silver, & Gold judges must have a minimum rating of 4/5.
- c. In an emergency situation Xcel may be reduced to a one judge panel and follow the USA Gymnastics R & P guidelines.

10. KQ reporting procedures:

- a. The following is due within 24 hours of the meet's conclusion:
 - i. The original Sanction Report form and the Coaches' Sign-in Sheet(s) to USA Gymnastics Member Services Department, 132 East Washington Street, Suite 700, Indianapolis, IN 46204.
- b. The following is due within 48 hours of the meet's conclusion:
 - i. A copy of Sanction Report form and \$1.00 per gymnast to Regional Administrative Chair: David Stiles, Region 5 RACC, 105 Woodland Lane, Carmel, IN 46032, (317) 504-8281 cell, (317) 849-7744 gym, gymcoachdave1@gmail.com
 - ii. A copy of Sanction Report form, \$2.00 per gymnast, and results to the State Administrative Chair: **Brian Blewitt, 2388 New Haven Road, Bardstown, KY 40004**
 - iii. A copy of the results must be in Excel format and emailed to Brian Blewitt, brianblewitt@blueribbonsports.net.
- c. Not following this rule constitutes an offence. The meet director and gym club will lose the privilege of hosting future competitions. USA Gymnastics rule!

Kentucky State Meets

1. State meet requirements:

- a. State meets must submit a bid form to the State Administrative Committee.
- b. State meets must be hosted by a Kentucky member club or Kentucky organization (KY NAWGJ).
- c. It is recommended the host site is not in-house (in gym). Other bids will be reviewed at the committee's discretion.
- d. Meet format must be Capital Cup or Modified Capital Cup (two sets of equipment)
 - i. **The new Modified Traditional #2 format is not acceptable for Kentucky State Meets.**
- e. The committee will compensate the host club for the additional cost of the second set of equipment, if requested by the host.
- f. An electronic scoring system must be used to display scores to spectators.
- g. State meets must follow the sanctioning procedures as listed in the USA Gymnastics R&P.
- h. State meets must follow the age group and awards requirements as described in the USA Gymnastics R&P and the Kentucky R&P.
- i. It is required that non removable wristbands be used as sign-in credentials at Kentucky state meets.
- j. **It is required to have an official trainer on site for the duration of the meet.**

2. State meet entry fees:

a. Levels 2 & 3	\$65.00
b. Levels 4 & 5	\$70.00
c. Levels 6 – 10	\$80.00
d. Event specialist	\$80.00
e. Xcel Bronze	\$65.00
f. Xcel Silver – Diamond	\$65.00

3. State meet qualifying score:

- a. Levels 2 – 5 31.00 at a KQ meet.
- b. Levels 6 – 8 31.00 at any USA Gymnastics sanctioned competition.
- c. Levels 9 & 10 32.00 at any USA Gymnastics sanctioned competition.
- d. Xcel 31.00 or equal event score average at a KQ meet.
- e. Levels 2 – 5 & Xcel gymnasts **MUST** compete in at least KQ meets and achieve the qualifying score in at least one KQ meet to qualify to State meet.
- f. For any optional using an out of state meet to qualify to state you must send a copy of the results **within 7 days of the meet** to Brian Blewitt, brianblewitt@blueribbonsports.net.

4. Optional level event specialist:

- a. An optional level gymnast may enter KY State meet as an event specialist and must qualify by achieving a score of 8.5 per event at any USA Gymnastics competition, maximum of 3 events.
- b. An event score from an all-around score in any USA Gymnastics sanctioned competition can be used to qualify to the KY State meet. The State committee will not require the gymnast to designate that they are competing as an individual specialist in pre-state meet competitions. (This is to reflect new discussions by the National J.O. committee and cleared with Tom Koll and Connie Maloney).
- c. Coaches must declare on the State Meet Entry form if the athlete is an event specialist or all-around, and they **MUST** compete that way at State and above.
- d. The entry fee will be the same as the all-around fee.
- e. **Athletes who are limited in the number of events in which they can perform due to a permanent physical handicap (verified by a physician) may petition to qualify to a higher level by achieving an average score equal to the average of the All-Around qualifying score for that level. Submit petitions in a formal written request for Levels 7 and below to the State Administrative Committee Chairman and the final decision is determined by the State Administrative Committee. For Levels 8 and above, petitions are sent to the Regional Administrative Committee Chairman and the final decision is determined by the Regional Administrative Committee.**

5. State declaration date:

- a. According to the USA Gymnastics R&P the state committee must set a declaration date, after which a gymnast may not drop back to a lower level for state meets.
- b. USA Gymnastics – Kentucky declaration date is **02/10/2017** for all levels.

6. State meet entry deadline:

- a. The deadline for all state meets is to be 4 weeks ahead of the meet date.
- b. Levels 2 & 3 **02/24/2017**
- c. Levels 4 – 10 **02/10/2017**
- d. Xcel **02/24/2017**
- e. All entries MUST be in hand to the meet director before the deadline or it will be considered late.
- f. All entries received after the deadline or if the entry is completed improperly will be charged a late fee of \$25.00 per gymnast.
- g. Entries must include:
 - i. Competitors and petitioned athletes' name(s), USA Gymnastics member number, birthdate, citizenship, age division, date of qualification, and score.
 - ii. The name(s) and USA Gymnastics professional number and safety certification expiration of all participating coaches.
 - iii. ALL FEES PAID IN FULL.

7. Qualifying for State meets after the deadline:

- a. List athletes who are attempting to qualify at the bottom of your meet entry form and list the competition that they will attempt qualifying in.
- b. DO NOT pay their fees if they have not qualified.
- c. On the Monday following the qualifying meet, you must contact the meet director and let them know if they qualified.
- d. A check must be postmarked on the Monday following the qualifying meet or you will owe the late fee!

8. State meets age determination: Age as of the last day of the championship meet.

- a. Levels 2 & 3 **03/26/2017** (State)
- b. Levels 4, 5, & 6 **03/12/2017** (State)
- c. Level 7 & 8 **04/23/2017** (Regional)
- d. Level 9 **04/30/2017** (Eastern)
- e. Level 10 **05/07/2017** (J.O. National)
- f. Xcel Bronze **03/26/2017** (State)
- g. Silver – Diamond **05/14/2017** (Regional)

9. State meet age groups and sizes:

- a. Consecutive ages can be combined.
- b. No single age group can exceed 15 athletes.
- c. Sessions may be divided by teams or by age groups.
- d. Must follow guidelines in USA Gymnastics R&P.

10. State meet awards requirements: Levels 2 – 10 & Xcel.

- a. Achievement ribbons are no longer required for events following the USA Gymnastics R&P.
- b. Individual events: placement medals, plaques, or trophies must be given to the top 1/3 of each age group. Additional awards may be given.
- c. All-around placements: gold, silver, and bronze by percentage to each gymnast. Also special recognition is given to the top 3 in each age group with medals, plaques, or trophies.
- d. Pre-meet information must describe the awards to be given at the meet.

11. State meet team awards:

- a. A team consists of a minimum of 3 gymnasts.
- b. The top 3 scores per event will be used to calculate ALL team awards.
- c. Every team that pays a team entry fee must receive a TEAM AWARD.
- d. Levels 2 & 3 will be divided into 2 team divisions (Large & Small)
 - i. Small team shall be 3 – 10 gymnasts
 - ii. Large team shall be 11 or more gymnasts
 - iii. Team size will be determined at time of meet entry

12. State meet judging requirements:

- a. Levels 2 – 8 must use a minimum of two judges per event.
- b. Levels 9 & 10 may not be combined with any other level and are expected to use a four judge panel. This session may have a two event rotation schedule.
- c. In the case that the entry numbers for levels 9 & 10 do not allow for a four judge panel, then a two judge panel system is acceptable.
- d. Xcel divisions Bronze, Silver, & Gold judges must have a minimum rating of 4/5.

13. State meet reporting procedures:

- a. The following is due within 24 hours of the meet's conclusion:
 - i. The original Sanction Report form and the Coaches' Sign-in Sheet(s) to USA Gymnastics Member Services Department, 132 East Washington Street, Suite 700, Indianapolis, IN 46204.
- b. The following is due within 48 hours of the meet's conclusion:
 - i. A copy of Sanction Report form and \$1.00 per gymnast to Regional Administrative Chair: David Stiles, Region 5 RACC, 105 Woodland Lane, Carmel, IN 46032, (317) 504-8281 cell, (317) 849-7744 gym, gymcoachdave1@gmail.com
 - ii. A copy of Sanction Report form, \$3.00 per gymnast (with \$1.00 dedicated to the State Banquet), and results to the State Administrative Chair: **Brian Blewitt, 2388 New Haven Road, Bardstown, KY 40004**
 - iii. A copy of the meet results (all-around and individual event scores for each level and age division) to the Regional Technical Chair, Char Christensen, 1260 Churchbell Way, Columbus, OH 43235
 - iv. A copy of the meet results (all-around and individual event scores for the appropriate level and age division) to the regional meet director.
 - v. A copy of the results must be in Excel format and emailed to Brian Blewitt, brianblewitt@blueribbonssports.net.
- c. The following is due within 45 days of the meet's conclusion:
 - i. The meet director must submit a financial report, including all income and expenses involved in the meet, to State Administrative Chair: **Brian Blewitt, 2388 New Haven Road, Bardstown, KY 40004**
- d. Not following this rule constitutes an offence. The meet director and gym club will lose the privilege of hosting future competitions. USA Gymnastics rule!

All other rules

1. Participant Regulations:

- a. Cell phones and texting:
 - i. The use of cell phones (for talking, texting, etc.) or any type of wireless communication device is prohibited while on the “field of play”. If a call must be made, it should be done outside the field of play. Exception: Walkie-talkies for the Meet Director and host club personnel and medical personnel are allowed.
 - ii. See the USA Gymnastics R&P for all other guidelines regarding electronic devices.
- b. Coaches credentials:
 - i. Professional and Jr. Professional members must be prepared to produce their current membership card or other event-specific credential at sign-in at all USA Gymnastics sanctioned events if requested.
 - ii. It is suggested that non removable wristbands be used as sign-in credentials at KQ meet.
 - iii. It is required that non removable wristbands be used as sign-in credentials at KY state meets.
- c. Be professional: Dress in appropriate attire that reflects the best image of gymnastics.
 - i. Dress code for all KQ and state meets as per USA Gymnastics – KY committee is as follows:
 1. Athletic shoes with rubberized soles.
 2. Athletic warm-up pants or Dockers-style pants (no jeans).
 3. Athletic or tailored shorts that are of reasonable length. No hole, tears, or short shorts.
 4. Collared shirts, casual shirts, or t-shirts with gym logo (no spaghetti straps, low cut tops, or midriff revealing shirts).
 5. No hats or visors.
 6. Be mentally and physically prepared and rested in order to provide the safest environment for the gymnast.
 7. Show respect for all gymnasts, coaches, judges, and meet personnel.
- d. It is the responsibility of the meet director to enforce any miscellaneous rule violations. Violators will be given a warning and the violation must be corrected before the next session of attendance. Meet credentials will be revoked. **A warning letter will be sent to the club that a coach was in violation.**

2. Sanction violations:

- a. Consult USA Gymnastics R&P.
- b. Kentucky requires all meet directors to file the required reports to the state and regional chairman.
- c. Refer to KQ reporting procedures for competition tax per gymnast on pages five and eight.

5. Mobility reporting:

- a. If you are using a sanctioned event that is not a KQ meet to move up in level you must email a copy of the results **within 7 days** to Brian Blewitt, brianblewitt@blueribbonsports.net.
- b. JO & Xcel Athletes may not skip any level or division.
- c. JO & Xcel Athletes must advance one level or division at a time by scoring the minimum mobility score, per USA Gymnastics R&P.
- d. Athletes may not use the Xcel program to skip any levels in the J.O. program, per USA Gymnastics R&P.

6. Deadline for 2017 – 2018 Calendar

- a. KQ bid acceptance dates are **June 1st, 2017 – June 30th, 2017** for the upcoming season.
- b. **No bids will be accepted early.**
- c. A State Calendar will be published for the upcoming season by **August 1st, 2017**.
- d. State meet bids must be submitted by **August 31st, 2017** for the upcoming season. State meets will be awarded and announced for the upcoming season following our September meeting.

HOW TO PETITION TO REGIONALS

ALL INFORMATION CONCERNING PETITIONING IS FOUND IN RULES & POLICIES, p. 16, 19-20.

Gymnasts may be petitioned to L. 8, 9, or 10 Regionals because of illness, injury, or a family tragedy (e.g., death, natural disaster).

A gymnast may compete in her State Meet in 1, 2, or 3 events, but not all four and still petition. (Touching out is NOT considered competing in that event.)

How to:

1. At the State Meet, the gymnast must be entered in the Regional Meet and **the fees must be paid.**
2. **Coaches must notify the Regional Administrative Committee Chair (Dave Stiles) by fax or email the Monday after the State meet of any athletes they intend to petition to Regionals.** His information (email, etc.) is in Rules and Policies on p. xi and on Region5.com.
3. The petition is due to me, Hilary Carlson, and also to the State Chair, (not postmarked, but due) by the Wednesday after the State Meet. It may be faxed, emailed, or sent Express Mail. It must include:
 - a. The petition form from the coach, found on the USAG and Region 5 websites. **THERE IS A NEW PETITION FORM THAT MUST BE USED. MAKE SURE YOU ARE USING THE ONE UPDATED IN FEB., 2014!!!**
 - b. A photocopy of one pre-state sanctioned meet from the current season or the previous year's Regional, Easterns, NIT, or National meet with a score at least 1.0 more than the qualifying score. (Levels 8, 9, and 10 need at least a 35.0.) The qualifying score for an event specialist is 9.0. Obviously the score must be at the Level to which she is petitioning. **Do not highlight scores if you are faxing it. The highlight blackens the score and name.**
 - c. **(Important!! New wording) A LICENSED MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL'S** written notice of illness or injury that kept the gymnast from competing on all four events at the State Meet.
 - d. **At least one week before the Regional meet,** we will need a licensed medical professional's release to compete. Sometimes the licensed medical professional will write the release date on the first written notice and sometimes will not. If the licensed medical professional just states that the gymnast was unable to compete, the release must be sent one week before the competition.
 - e. **If an approved petition athlete scratches from the meet, there is no refund unless it is done 10 days or more from the meet start date.** (Clarification by the Region V Committee, 7/12.)
4. If you do not get a response from me within 3 days of submission, please contact me again. I may not have received it for some reason.

USA Gymnastics Kentucky Hall of Fame Criteria

Mission: To recognize people within Kentucky who have contributed significantly to the growth, promotion or visibility of USA Gymnastics Kentucky with service, dedication and a positive outcome.

Procedures: Any current USA Gymnastics professional member may submit a nomination to the Kentucky State Administrative Committee Chair. The Board will review the nominations, verify their content and make a silent vote with a majority of the vote needed for selection. Inductees will be honored at the State USA Gymnastics banquet.

Coach criteria: Minimum of 10 years of service to Kentucky. Have coached one or more gymnasts that have qualified to State Championships. Has contributed at Kentucky clinics, on gymnastic committees and has been a positive factor in developing a program.

Athlete Criteria: Minimum of 5 years of competition in Kentucky. Has qualified to Regional Championships and above, and/or continued in Collegiate competition. Has contributed to the enhancement of gymnastics with peers and other gymnastic programs in a positive manner.

Contributor/Judge Criteria: Has served in Kentucky for a minimum of 10 years. Has served significantly on Kentucky gymnastic committees. Has contributed to the advancement of coaching or gymnasts other than their personal athletes. Has supported numerous teams, coaches and athletes. Judges must hold Level 10 or above credentials, having judged State or Regional and above competitions.

Publicity: The information about the Hall of Fame will be on the Kentucky USA Gymnastics and NAWGJ websites and sent out to the Clubs and Judges via email.

Active Applications: Applications will remain active for a maximum of 5 years. The person that nominated the nominee should send updates to the application and will be notified when the application has expired.

Removal from the Hall of Fame: A Kentucky Hall of Fame or Contributor inductee will be automatically removed if the USA Gymnastics has removed their membership or they have been convicted of any felony. For any other reason a majority of the Kentucky USA Gymnastics Board is needed for the nominee to be removed.

Award: To be determined by the Kentucky USAG Board. The ongoing plaque listing all the inductees will be maintained by the State USA Gymnastics Chair.
